To Whom It May Concern:

At Reyes Coca-Cola Bottling (RCCB) we are committed to making a positive impact in the communities where we live and work. As part of our commitment, we believe in the power and necessity of working together to lift those around us and leave a better world for future generations. We concentrate on specific areas where we believe we can make the biggest difference, including the efficient use of water. We strive to reduce water usage, improve water treatment processes, evaluate our water usage impact, and replenish the water sources in our communities.

As the largest bottling operation in RCCB's portfolio, and the largest Coca-Cola bottling plant in North America, RCCB's Downey, California production center plays a key role in the company's water strategy. RCCB Downey is adopting the Alliance for Water Stewardship (AWS) standard, which consolidates our efforts in water sustainability and stewardship under a globally recognized framework.

Implementing the AWS standard will enable our employees in Downey, service providers, local communities and other stakeholders to understand shared water-related challenges within the local catchment area. It will also reduce operational and supply chain water risks by fostering relationships with local communities, water service providers, industry partners, authorities and non-governmental organizations (NGOs).

The RCCB Downey Leadership Team commits to:

- Continuously support onsite water-related projects to improve water efficiency and reduce the Downey plant's Water Use Ratio (WUR).
- Support the site's water stewardship initiatives and identify shared water challenges within our site boundaries and the local catchment area.



- Encourage ongoing efforts to enhance water stewardship actions and foster positive collaboration with communities and stakeholders in the local catchment area.
- Respect the right of RCCB employees and communities within the local catchment area to save and adequate Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) access.
- Support local and national authorities in promoting good water governance within the local catchment area.
- Collaborate with NGOs active in water stewardship endeavors within the local catchment area.
- Comply with all water-related legal and regulatory requirements.
- Allocate adequate and appropriate human and financial resources to successfully achieve and maintain AWS certification.
- Publicly share our progress against stated water stewardship targets at least annually.
